"Bobbin' John" refers to John Erskine, (23rd/6th Earl of Mar) who was an important Jacobite military leader during the 1715 Jacobite rising.

It was printed in Gow's **2nd Repository** (1802), Petrie's **Fourth Collection of Strathspeys, Reels, Jiggs and Country Dances** (c. 1805) and Williamson's **English, Welsh, Scottish and Irish Fiddle Tunes** (1976) where he pairs it with "Cam Ye O'er frae France".
