

The Boys of Tralee

"The Boys of Tralee", also known as "Katie's Fancy" is an Irish double jig in 6/8 time and G Major. The parts are played AABB.

It is very similar to O'Neill's "Katie's Fancy" although "The Boys of Tralee" lacks a C part. It was printed in Darley & McCall's *Feis Ceoil Collection of Irish Music* (1914), Kerr's *Merry Melodies*, vol. 4 (c. 1880's) and Banalari's *Celtic Encyclopedia* (1999).
