

## Connie Walsh's Slide

"Connie Walsh's Slide" also known as "The *Cúil Aodha* Slide" is an Irish slide in 12/8 time and D Major. The parts are played AABB.

Connie Walsh was a *Sliabh Luachra* fiddle player who emigrated to America.

*Sliabh Luachra* accordion player Johnny O'Leary remembered only this one slide:

"...he used always play that tune before--in any dance that was his first and only slide, I'd say, he had. He hadn't many more of them I'd say".
