"Paddy Reynolds' Dream", also known as "Paddy Reynolds' Favorite" is an Irish jig in D Major/Mixolydian. The parts are played AABBC.

Staten Island, New York, fiddler Paddy Reynolds says that he had not composed the tune, only arranged it and added a third part. Paddy Reynolds was originally from Ballinamuck, County Longford and immigrated to New York in 1948.
