"The Wind That Shakes the Barley", in Gaelic "*An Ghaoth a Bhogann*", also known as "Da Wind Dat Shakes Da Barley", "The Kerry Lasses", "The Little Pack of Tailors", "The Pack of Tailors", "The Wind That Blows The Barley Down" is a reel in D.

This tune is known in Irish, Scottish, Shetland, American & New England traditions.

The banjo tablature is by John Letscher.

This tune has been recorded by Jean Carignan, Martin Carthy, Planxty, Sean Keane, Cathal McConnel, Alasdair Fraser and others.

It has been printed in James Stewart Robertson's **The Athole Collection** (1884), Keith Norman MacDonald's **The Skye Collection** (1887), George Petrie's **Ancient Music of Ireland** (1855) and Frank Roche's **The Roche Collection of Traditional Irish Music, Volume I** (1911).
