An Ookpic is a popular Inuit handicraft toy. It is a small souvenir owl with large head and big eyes, a beak, and small black talons. They are often made from wolf fur, sealskin and other traditional materials.

*Ukpik* is the Inuktitut word for snowy owl.

The "Ookpic Waltz" was published in 1965 by the late Mission, British Columbia, fiddler Frankie Rodgers.
