
The Storms Are On the Ocean

"The Storms Are on the Ocean" was sung by The Carter Family at the 1927 Bristol Sessions recordings. It was published by Ralph Peer's Southern Music Publishing Company in the Carter Family songbook **Album of Smoky Mountain Ballads** (1927). This is another one of the "who's gonna shoe your foot ..." songs which go all the way back to the Scottish ballad of **Lord Gregory**. In this collection these include:

"I Truly Understand"

"Who's Gonna Shoe Your Pretty Little Foot" and Woody Guthrie's "Hard, Ain't It Hard".

I like to do this in D with the guitar capoed up 2. When I sing it with the autoharp, I play and sing in C. I usually perform this with autoharp.
