

## Nancy's got a Pretty Dress on

"Nancy's got a Pretty Dress on" is an American reel in cut time and D Major. The parts are played AAB.

This 'crooked' (one measure is rhythmically irregular) tune was recorded by collector Alan Lomax in 1959 from the playing of Ozarks fiddler Absolum (Absie) Morrison (1876-1964) of Landis, Searcy County, Arkansas.

"Blue Mule" or "Old Blue Mule" is a related melody.
